

Champions of Hope are high school juniors or senior boys are who participate in a leadership, philanthropy and service program hosted by Centers for Youth and Families. Congratulations on being nominated to be one of 30 Champions of Hope for the 2019-2020 class!

You have been unanimously selected by the Centers for Youth and Families Foundation Board of Trustees to serve as a Champion of Hope. We look forward to you being part of this fall's class.

The Champions of Hope activities take place from September to March.

Champions who complete program requirements will:

- Complete up to 20 service hours.
- Earn a certificate of recognition and letters of recommendation for college applications and scholarship applications.
- Be recognized during The Evolve Gala at the Statehouse Convention Center on Saturday, March 14, 2020.
- Be given three tickets to The Evolve Gala (value \$450).

Program requirements:

- 1. Champions have a commitment of \$1,500 to be gifted or raised to benefit boys and girls served by Centers for Youth and Families. All commitment gifts are invested in programs that help boys and girls overcome trauma and abuse and begin pathways to success. The Centers' will provide support for fundraising activities.
- 2. A minimum of \$250 is required by Monday, September 9. The entire commitment must be completed by February 21, 2020.
- 3. Each young man completes a minimum of 20 volunteer hours with The Centers for Youth and Families.
- 4. Champions serve as representatives of their families, schools, peers, and The Centers for Youth and Families, and as models for good behavior, ethics and morals standards.
- 5. Champions must attend at least 50% of program activities.
- 6. Schedule an appointment with Photography by Melisa by December 31, 2019. (*There is no cost to have your photograph taken; however, you will be able to purchase your photograph.*)
- 7. Parents of Champions are asked to provide a meal or snack for one program activity.


